What is the Callfinder®?

The Callfinder® is an electronic device that unlocks printed sound information. It does not require an internet connection or data for normal use. Detailed information on how to operate the device can be found in the instruction manual which is included in the Callfinder® package. The Callfinder® is battery operated and, depending on the model, is either rechargeable or uses normal AAA batteries.

What is Callfinder® ready?

The Callfinder® ready logo on the cover identifies a publication that is enabled with added sound data. The sound data or sound file is a completely separate product. The book can be used without the Callfinder®, but the experience is greatly enhanced by adding the Callfinder® functionality. The Callfinder®, which is sold separately, might initially be preloaded with a specific sound file, but additional sound files must be purchased and downloaded. Sound files may be updated from time to time, and can be downloaded at no extra cost. Several other language sound files are under development and will be available for download from the publisher.



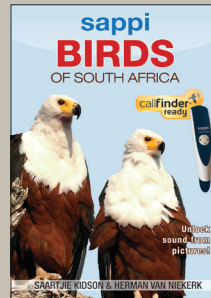
Where can I buy the Callfinder®?

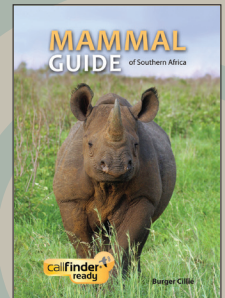
How does the Callfinder® work?

Specific areas on the page are coded with an “invisible” grid of dots. The Callfinder® identifies the unique code and plays the sound file linked to the specific code. The *Talking Dictionary* contains more than 5 300 of these sound codes.
